Dear Sir or Madam,

the newly elected board of our association CAMHAN (Cameroonian Community Hanover) has for his term taken on the task of supporting the integration and development of its members in Hannover and Germany especially. In this sense, participation in many events is being planned.

In January 2010 we became a member of the Challenge Camerounais eV. The main task of the Challenge Camerounais is to assemble the Cameroonian clubs in Germany. It is characterized by hosting one of today's biggest annual social, cultural and sporting events in Europe, from the Cameroonian Diaspora. Since 1992 - and with currently about 6000 visitors from all over the world-this event has become one of the most important platforms for the German-Cameroonian exchange in social, cultural and economic fields.

The event takes place this year in Berlin. It begins on the evening of 17 May and ends on 20 with a gala. Planned are a handball tournament for women, football and basketball for men, as well as table tennis and track and field competitions. All weekend long an open-air festival will be held to accompany the sporting activities. With a variety of traditional dances, singing, gospel music, theatrical performances and quiz shows the diversity of the Cameroonian culture is celebrated. The meeting, however, is not only used for pleasure. As part of the "Business & Social Forum", Cameroonian and German entrepreneurs will meet. In addition, students will be prepared by lectures and workshops on the job entry in German and Cameroonian businesses.

CAMHAN derives its finances mainly from membership fees and donations. To participate in this important event for us, we are dependent on financial support, we hereby apply to you. With this letter you will receive our estimate as an attachment.

We have sent out several applications in relation to gain support. The highest hurdle remains the accommodation for a total of 34 participants (students) from Hannover to this three-day event. So, we were able to find and reserve flats (4) with the minimum comfort in Berlin for a total price of € 2,241. In our (online) search, we have therefore restricted down
